Apologies

The group met by conference call to discuss Bolton Council's decision following the tabling of the approval for our neighbourhood plan area and boundaries at their meeting.

An extract from their minutes is below.

Further to Minute 102 of the meeting of the Executive Cabinet Member for Regeneration and Resources, the Director of Place submitted a report which requested the Executive Cabinet Member to determine the applications received for the designation of a neighbourhood area and neighbourhood forum in Over Hulton following the recent publicity period.

The report reminded the Executive cabinet minister that he had given approval at his meeting on 8th May 2017 to publicise the applications in accordance with the statutory process.

The report advised that the period of publicity had ended on 30th June 2017, however a decision on the applications was deferred at the meeting on 26 July 2017 to allow the applicants to submit further information. It was stated that the additional information had now been received and the Council had carried out further consultation on it. The Director of Place had confirmed that since the report had been prepared, a further letter had been submitted objecting to the applications.

Following a recommendation by the Cabinet Member for Development and Regeneration and Human Resources, the Executive Cabinet agreed that a decision on the applications for neighbourhood area and neighbourhood forum was to be deferred for consideration at their next meeting to enable officers to consider the recent objection which had been received.

DP recommended that the Committee met as soon as possible in order to discuss next steps due to Bolton Council having pressure put on them by Peel L&P.
